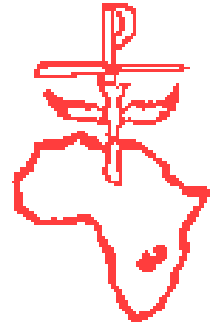

This course gives a student a unique opportunity to develop entrepreneurship skills and to acquire knowledge and practical skills in the maintenance and repair of office other electronic equipments such as:

1. Computers
2. Photocopiers
3. Fax machines
4. Electronic Typewriters
5. Televisions (Black & White and Colour)
6. Radios
7. Video Cassette Recorders and
8. DVD Players

1 year Trade test

- **Employed technicians** in Repairing televisions, radios, computers, photocopiers, etc., in Telecommunications, Broadcasting, Security firms, Defense forces, Electronic & Office Repair Companies, etc.



GENERAL AGRICULTURE CRAFT CERTIFICATE

This course gives a student a rare opportunity to acquire knowledge and practical skills in “hands on” agriculture covering:

1. Crop Production 1 & 2
2. Soil Science
3. Animal Production (Poultry, Rabbits, Pigs, Beef and Dairy)
4. Farm Management 1 & 2
5. Farm Engineering
6. Entrepreneurship and
7. Fish Farming.

1 year (Trade test)

Grade 12 with at least 3 – 5 passes including English and Mathematics.

Grade 9 for trade test.



OPPORTUNITIES FOR GRADUATES

Exciting opportunities await the graduates in this field:

- **Self-employed** managers on their own, a family, or hired farm, as a supplier of agro-inputs, small scale poultry and dairy production, or a middleman in output supply (complemented by entrepreneurship skills while on training)
- **Farm manager or supervisor**, Agriculture Extension and **field officers** under in NGOs and Government in rural development programmes, Marketing & Cooperative officers, Farmer advisor, etc.



CARPENTRY AND JOINERY

This course gives a student the opportunity to acquire knowledge and “hands on” practical skills in Carpentry & Joinery covering:

1. Health and Safety Regulation of the Workshop
2. Workshop Tools
3. Site tools/Introduction to Industry
4. Basic Drawings
5. Timber Shapes
6. Woodwork Joints
7. Timber Roofs & Ceilings
8. Centres for segmental and semicircular arches
9. Wooden shuttering for Foundation Columns
10. and Floors
11. Timber Partitions and
12. Entrepreneurship

DESIGNING, CUTTING & TAILORING

This course gives a student a broader opportunity to acquire knowledge and “hands on” practical skills in Cutting, Designing and tailoring covering:

1. Trade Science, Tools and Equipment
2. Pattern Constructions
3. Drawing, Designing & Making up Garments
4. Materials
5. Computer Application and Computer Aided Design (CAD)
6. Entrepreneurship
